Congratulations to Leslie and Don Jeszewski, Highcroft Collies

2013 AKC Breeder of the Year – Group Recipients

Herding: Leslie and Don Jeszewski, Highcroft Collies

Highcroft Collies was established by Leslie and Don in 1981. The AKC-registered Highcroft kennel prefix is recognized both nationally and by serious Collie breeders and fanciers around the world, with Highcroft Collies residing in various countries in North America, South America, Europe, Asia, and Australia.

Through their combined efforts, Leslie and Don have either bred or finished over 300 AKC champion Collies. The pair owned the number-one top-winning rough Collie in the United States in 2004, who, *owner-handled*, went Best of Breed at Westminster that year (over 13 rough specials) and also won the Collie Club of America National Specialty Show. That dog's name was Ch. Highcroft Lode-Ark's Legend ROM, four-time CCA Award of Merit winner. His photo was chosen by the parent club to be the visual representation of the Collie standard in the newly revised *AKC Complete Dog Book*. Leslie and Don have also received the Collie Club of America Presidential Award for Breeder of the Year four times.

Library of Champion Books – Karen Anderson, Chair

For approval of the Board. Bid from Jostens Printers for printing of American Collie Champions Vol 8 (2004-2007) - the Library of Champions. Please see the actual bid, which is attached.

Vol 8 will include the years 2004-2007. That is four years. There are approx 250 photos for each of those years that have been submitted for inclusion in the book. So just over 1000 photos will be in the book. Too bad we will be missing approximately 150 champions in each of those years because their owners did not submit a usable photo.

Calculation ROUNDING UP on each item

From the Jostens bid for 500 books - \$23 for printing, California sales tax of \$2, \$2 for shipping box, \$5 for mailing. But additional cost for bringing the books down to me on a pallet was about \$800 last time. I am guessing about the same so another \$2. Total costs = \$34 This is the Break Even Cost.

400 books - printing and tax \$11514 or \$29 each. The shipping box, mailing cost and delivery charge is \$9 combined, so 400 books would cost \$38

600 books - printing and tax \$13170 or \$22 each. The shipping box, mailing cost and delivery charge is \$9 combined, so 600 books would cost \$31

After the last volume I am concerned that I can sell 600 books. I think we should look at the 400 or 500 range. Pre-orders will determine the final count.

I will ship the finished books to the national for pick up. I will ship the remaining after the national.

I would like the Board to approve the pre-sales price of \$40 and \$45 for non-members. Once pre-sales are over the price would be \$50 and \$55 for non-members.

Breeders and purchasers should be aware that there are differences in grading systems and between individual examiners' findings, and inform themselves about the health subjects.
