The secretary passed out sign-up sheets for those in attendance. The President called the meeting to order at 4:14 PM after the day's judging. He welcomed all directors and guests and asked all to introduce themselves to the group. Then asked all online were asked to introduce themselves as present for the meeting. The President asked if there was a quorum present and the answer was yes.

The President asked if there were any reports from the secretary and the answer was we have received a resignation as district director from Brenda Knight, OR. Election ballots will be made and sent to the State of OR to replace her after the National. Then Mike Esch presented his treasurer's report which he passed out copies to all in the room, then stated it would be available for review in the next Communique'.

Reports: The President asked that Lori Montero, Realignment Committee chair, speak on the ideas behind the proposals for realignment. She also mentioned the discussion with the Constitution Committee to bring down the number of directors from proposal presented in 2013 of 15 district directors plus all 5 officers to one presented recently of 10 district directors with 3 officers. During the meeting it was discussed that all officers should have voting rights plus directors agreeing on 15 people on the Board in the new Constitution proposal.

New Business:

- **1.** The proposal from Butch Schulman. Take the Lead Gala proposal from Butch Schulman. 3/3/15 Motion made by Susan Kaelin and seconded by Emily Berkley. I would like to make the motion that we vote to approve the 2016 Take the Lead Gala at the Board Meeting next week. Copies of this proposal were presented to the Board on 3/3/15 in a letter from Butch Schulman. This proposal is for the CCA to "take the lead" as the host chair for the event at the Kentuckian shows where we will give a donation in the amount of \$3750 to support the efforts to give back to our fellow collie fanciers in the sport of purebred dogs. Chairing the event will be our own Butch Schulman and co-chair, Susan Kaelin, district director for the CCA KY. The Gala is a huge fundraiser to help those in the sport of dogs. This issue passed with a unanimous vote by the Board.
