### SHOW RULES COMMITTEE CHANGES

The National Show Rules Committee chaired by Joe Reno presents the following changes to the present National Show Rules document.

#### CHANGES MADE and SECTIONS

7. B. 17 If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the Host Show Committee, in conjunction with the National Show Committee, shall determine what, if any, refunds shall be given.

8.L. Show cancellation: If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the club will reimburse the Judge for expenses incurred to them prior to the cancelation notice being conveyed to them. This reimbursement will be only for expenses that cannot be canceled or refunded.

8.M. Judge cancellation: If the Judge must cancel or is unable to fulfill their contract for any reason, neither fees nor expenses will be paid by the club. Judges should please give the club immediate notice if they become aware of the fact that they must cancel so that the club may make alternate arrangements for their assignment.

10.B.9. If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the three scheduled conformation Judges will have the option of judging the next scheduled National, whose judges have not been determined.

App. A. 7. If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the club will reimburse the Judge for expenses incurred to them prior to the cancelation notice being conveyed to them.

App. A. 8. If the Judge must cancel or is unable to fulfill their contract for any reason, neither fees nor expenses will be paid by the club. Judges should please give the club immediate notice if they become aware of the fact that they must cancel so that the club may make alternate arrangements for their assignment.

App. C. 7. 

There is a horse barn with an enclosed space for the trial secretary, a grill for lunch and dinner barbecues, rest rooms and 6 stalls that can be used for dogs, or for overnight camping on a first come/first serve basis.

#### CHANGES MADE and SECTIONS

7. B. 17 If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the Host Show Committee, in conjunction with the National Show Committee, shall determine what, if any, refunds shall be given.

8.L. Show cancellation: If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the club will reimburse the Judge for expenses incurred to them prior to the cancelation notice being conveyed to them. This reimbursement will be only for expenses that cannot be canceled or refunded.

8.M. Judge cancellation: If the Judge must cancel or is unable to fulfill their contract for any reason, neither fees nor expenses will be paid by the club. Judges should please give the club immediate notice if they become aware of the fact that they must cancel so that the club may make alternate arrangements for their assignment.

10.B.9. If the show is canceled due to acts of nature, war, or other matters outside the control of the club, the three scheduled conformation Judges will have the option of judging the next scheduled National, whose judges have not been determined.
