Bid Proposal – Regional Herding

The Collie Club of America Working Collie Committee (WCC) is currently soliciting bids from interested herding collie enthusiasts to chair/host CCA Herding Regionals. Bids should not be within 60 days of CCA Nationals. Preference will be given to trials proposed in the late summer and fall. The WCC will select sites based upon number of course/stock combinations available, budgetary considerations, experience of the bidder, completeness and thoroughness of the proposal, and distribution of three Regional sites across the country. The WCC may ask questions of or request additional information from any or all bidders prior to making its selections. Bids will be posted to the CCA Performance Yahoo site for review. Bids are due October 31 for the coming trial year. Selected sites will be announced by November 30 to allow for AKC 6 month filing requirement.
