Show Site

The Cabarrus Arena and Events Center for Conformation and Obedience is climate controlled facilities with plentiful electrical outlets. It is 15 minutes from the Host Hotel Cluster. No city traffic. Unloading will be allowed at designated areas. Building will be available to vendors and exhibitors on Monday afternoon, March 26, 2007. Security guards will be on duty overnight. **Building will be open from 6 AM - 11pm on Mon and Tues March 26 & 27, 2007. On judging days March 28, 2007 to Saturday March 31, 2007 the building will be open at 5:30 am - 11 pm daily.**

The Cabarrus Arena and Events Center offers parking passes for the duration of the show at \$25 per vehicle or \$5 for daily access.

Herding will be held in Sanford, NC within 90 minutes of the Cabarrus Arena and Events Center. Herding Trial & Test for sheep will be at Way To Me Farm in Sanford. Practice fields available on Saturday, March 24 for those who can come early - \$10 per run. Collies Only. Herding will be on Sunday & Monday March 25 & 26.

Agility will be held at **the Cabarrus Midway at the Arena and Events Center**. Collies only. Tuesday and Wednesday, March 27 & 28.

Obedience and Rally will be held in **Gold Hall 2** - a separate building adjacent to the Events Center on Thursday and Friday March 29 & 30th.

Directions To Show Site

From the Host Hotel Cluster to the Show Site:

Start out going south on Gateway Ln toward Weddington Rd. Turn right onto Weddington Rd. Turn left onto Speedway Blvd. Turn left onto Concord Pkwy S/ US-29 N. Turn slight right onto Cabarrus Ave W. Turn right onto US-601 Byp S/ Warren C Coleman Blvd. Continue to follow US-601 Bypass S. Turn left to take the NC-49 N Ramp. Turn slight right onto NC-49. End at Cabarrus Arena & Events Ctr 4751 Highway 49 N, Concord, NC 28025.

From Herding Site to Show Site:

Turn left out of drive, turn right on Lick Creek, left on lower Moncure Road/11th Street. Turn right onto Charlotte Avenue, which become US 1. Stay on US 1/NC 42, Merge left onto 15/501 South (15 miles). Merge onto 24 W (32 miles), bear left to stay on 24W, Gilead Road (18 miles), then become East Main Street. Turn right onto NC 73 (15 miles), left on 49 S toward Charlotte, then immediate right on 49 S. Cabarrus Arena and Events Center is on right at Airport Road intersection, approximately 90 miles total.

Weather: March is generally known for its mild temperatures. The average daytime temperature is 65. Generally be prepared for extremes from warm, humid days to cold, rainy ones; and nights from sultry to shivering.

Dr. Karen Muñana will be our speaker at the March 29, 2007 CHF dinner and auction - her research is a pilot study that she hopes can be expanded to applications for other breeds and humans alike! She and an assistant will be available at CCA on Thursday and Friday, hoping to solicit additional candidates for their study. MDR-1 testing will be free of charge for Collies qualifying for this valuable research.

Dr. Muñana is an Associate Professor of Neurology at NC State University College of Veterinary Medicine and a Diplomate, American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine in Neurology. The focus of her research at NCSU is Inflammatory disorders of the central nervous system in dogs and cats: focusing on potential causes, pathogenesis of disease, and development of methods to aid in diagnosis; Epilepsy in dogs, with focus on alternative treatments of seizure control in patients that respond poorly to available medications.
