**SET UP and CRATING**

We have a record entry this year. We would appreciate everyone complying with these instructions to ensure that the trial runs efficiently.

Setup in the Midway begins at 7:30 am on Tuesday. Please **DO NOT** set up prior to this time in the Midway. You may unload in Gold Hall from 6am to 11pm on Monday prior to the trial.

Due to the record entry, there will be very limited space available under CCoFA provided tents. No Xpens under the tent. Please bring an EZ Up if at all possible. You may use Xpens under EZ Ups. Due to buried electrical lines, **DO NOT STAKE ANYTHING INTO THE GRASS.**

**PARKING**

The trial is outdoors, on grass in the Midway area. To reach the Midway, go to the right of the main front parking lot and look for the Gated entrance near the Lake (also near Gold Hall). This gate will be open and is the gate for the Obedience/Rally exhibitors as well. You will be allowed to park on the grass near the rings, but please follow instructions as we have a lot of cars to get into a small area. Please park close to the person next to you. Please **DO NOT** go around the main road at the back end of the building where the RV lot is to get to the Midway area. Please take the gated entrance near the Lake to the right of the main front parking lot.

**FOOD AND RESTROOMS**

Concession and restrooms are a short walk away. Folks who volunteer for two classes each day will be provided with a complimentary lunch voucher each day they work.

**CONFLICTS**

We will make every effort to work with conflicts. Please understand that we cannot hold the ring after the class has finished, nor are we able to make accommodation for folks who do not check in. *If you have a conflict, it is your responsibility to check in prior to your class and notify the gate steward of a conflict.* If you do not check in prior to your class and are not available to run in order, you will be marked absent. You are welcome to call Ericka on her cell phone at 901-828-0662 to find out what class/height are currently running so that you can determine what time you need to be at the ring.

**UNENTERED DOGS**

Pursuant to *Chapter 11, Section 11* of the *AKC Rules & Regulations*: Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the event precincts, except that dogs engaged as a special attraction with American Kennel Club approval may also be present.

**WEATHER**

Anything can happen with the weather in March. Please make sure you bring adequate clothing and provisions for you and your dog, including sun protection.

**Check-in:** This trial will have self-service check-in for those of you who have given me your height cards. Check in is at 7:30 a.m. on both days. **IF** the trial secretary has a photocopy of your dog's official AKC Jump Height card, you will pick up your handler envelope containing armband stickers for the weekend. Copies of the running order and course maps also will be available. There will be a minimum of **catalogs available for \$3.00 per catalog**. More can be printed as requested. **IF** your dog needs to be measured, or the trial secretary has NOT received a copy of your dog's official AKC Jump Height card, your dog must be measured and/or its jump height card inspected before you receive your armbands.

**Jump Height Cards:** If you do not have a copy of your height card, your dog must be measured before it can compete. Any dog that is measured taller than the jump height in which it was entered will be moved to the higher jump class immediately. If your dog has never been measured, you should practice having the dog stand still and remain quiet so that measuring will be fair and accurate. **There will be 2 VMOs at this trial.**

**Directions to the Trial Site From the Host Hotel Cluster**

Start out going south on Gateway Lane toward Weddington Rd. Turn right onto Weddington Rd. Turn left onto Speedway Blvd. Turn left onto Concord Pkwy S/US-29 N. Turn slight right onto Cabarrus Ave W. Turn right onto US-601 Byp S/Warren C Coleman Blvd. Continue to follow US-601 Bypass S. Turn left to take the NC-49 N Ramp. Turn slight right onto NC-49. End at Cabarrus Arena & Events Ctr 4751 Highway 49 N, Concord, NC 28025.

**Veterinarian on Call:** Foster's Animal Hospital, Dr. Stephen Foster & Dr. Kari Hyatt, 730 Concord Parkway, Concord, NC 28027, 704-786-0104. 8.5 miles from show site. Leaving arena, turn right out of parking lot. Go 3.2 miles to first exit Rt. 601 N. and turn right. 601/209 divides to 601 Business (Union St) and 601/29 By-Pass. Take the left 601 By-Pass. Rt 29 comes in from the left and the Hospital is 1.2 miles on the right just passed the Concord Animal Clinic.
