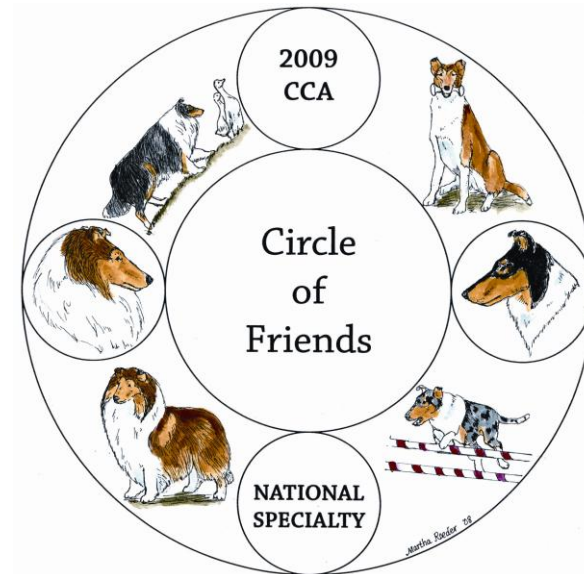

ENTRY FEES

DIRECTIONS TO TWO SHADOWS FARM

From NORTHEAST, EAST, or SOUTH EAST Via MASS PIKE

Get onto Mass Pike **West**

Travel to **Exit 9**, Sturbridge

Take exit 9 and after passing through tolls, stay to right and get off on **20 West**.

Follow **20 West** to **Rte 148 North** (right hand turn)

Follow **148 North** 7.6 miles to where it intersects with Rte **9 West**

Follow Rte 9 a few miles into the center of West Brookfield

Just before the common (large open green area), bear **right** (keep common on left)

Go straight through stop sign and cross Rte 67

Take immediate **right** onto **New Braintree Road**

Follow this road approximately 4.5 miles (it turns into **West Brookfield Rd.**)

Turn **left** onto **Gilbertville Road**. Travel 1.3 miles down to **Skivira Lane on left**. House is white colonial w/green shutters - 1st on right on corner. Caution turning into the road – **dangerous intersection**.

From SOUTH WEST (CT)

Rte 84 to Rte **20 West**

Follow as above

From WEST (Springfield)

Take Mass Pike East to exit **8/Palmer**

Take a **left** off the exit onto **Rte 32 North**

Follow 32 approximately 7 miles up into the center of Ware (passing Walmart/Lowes/various stores)

Rte 32 takes a **right** turn at the top of a hill and merges with **Rte 9**

Continue on 32/9 through Ware Center (mill buildings)

About 1.7 miles from Ware center, **Rte 32** will bear off to the **Left** and 9 will continue straight. **BEAR LEFT on 32**

Follow 32 down into the town of Gilbertville for 3.1 miles to traffic light at RR tracks

CAUTION – FOLLOW SPEED LIMITS AS POLICE TICKET HEAVILY HERE

Take a **right** onto **New Braintree Road** and travel approximately 2.8 miles

Look for orange signs noting a “dangerous intersection” and a pond on the left

Skivira Lane is around this corner on the **right**. Caution as it is a dangerous intersection. House is white colonial w/green shutters - 1st on right on corner.

Test classes: Herding Tested and Pre-Trial Test - Sheep, \$50 per entry per day.

Trial classes: Courses A & B (Started, Intermediate, Advanced) – Sheep, \$50 per entry per day; Ducks, \$40 per entry per day.

Exhibition Only trial runs:- Sheep, \$15.00 per entry.

Drawing for running order will take place at the home of the Trial Secretary at 5 PM on March 19, 2009.

Eligibility: Open ONLY to Rough and Smooth Collies registered with The American Kennel Club or that have been granted an PAL (ILP) number and that are nine (9) months of age or older.

ENTRIES

- Email will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.

- **Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.**

- **Telegraph, telephone, incomplete or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.**

- All entry fees payable in US funds. **Entries without full fees will not be accepted.**

- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in the maker's entries being accepted on a CASH ONLY basis.

- **Errors on Entry Blanks:** Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in case of any such errors after the closing date.

ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, March 18 at 12pm. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical.

Declination of entries: The Committee may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have recourse against the CCA, any official thereof, or any judge.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian, Judge, or Tester, or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the organizing committee, it is impossible to open or complete the test/trial, no refund of entry will be made. Extreme weather conditions, including, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme temperatures, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, livestock, exhibitors, judges and spectators. The well being of dogs, livestock, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the test/trial before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Collie Club of Connecticut and Hartford-Springfield Collie Club offer the Lois Russell Perpetual Remembrance to honor a gracious lady in the sport of herding with our beloved breed, the Collie. Lois Russell was instrumental in her efforts resulting in the AKC and CCA adopting herding as an event to restore our breed's working heritage. Also, the Collie Club of Connecticut and Hartford-Springfield Collie Club wish to pay tribute to Lois' ten years of service as Connecticut's District Director.

The annual winner will receive a copy of the bronze bas relief casting of the herding scene mounted on the side of the Lois Russell Perpetual Remembrance to be provided by the Collie Club of Connecticut and Hartford-Springfield Collie Clubs.

The winner must be a Collie Club of America member owning the highest scoring Collie with a qualifying score on sheep from any course A class at the National Herding Trial. In years with multiple trials, there will be only one bas relief casting award.

In the event of a multiple trial event creating a tie or a one-day event with tie score classes, the winner is to be determined by AKC Herding Regulations Chapter 4, Section 9, "Ties." If necessary, in years when the CCA National Specialty Herding Trial follows the breed and obedience judging day, the Collie Club of Connecticut and Hartford-Springfield Collie Clubs will be responsible for coordinating the return of the Lois Russell Perpetual Remembrance to the herding chairman or trophy chairman at their expense.
