IMPORTANT - TRANSFER of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11 Section 6, AKC Rules) **MUST** be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. **TRANSFERS** by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class **MUST** be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. **SUBSTITUTIONS** of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. **MOVE UP OF DOGS IN OBEDIENCE/ RALLY CLASSES** (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations) The request for a move up must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move ups for Obedience may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
