# Please state the top three virtues you believe are most important in relation to the Collie standard?

EXPRESSION: the sweet soul-searching, mischievous look on their face that draws you in and melts your heart.

HEAD DETAILS: the set and placement of the eye in the skull, the rounded muzzle with fill under the eye, a flat back skull with occipital bone that creates that parallel plane to the muzzle; and a lean skull.

BODY: balanced body with curves (tip of the ear, Arch of neck, level topline, sloped croup, well bent stifle, and chest). Reach and drive in balance front and rear and an effortless gait.
